How to get started:

- Watch this quick introduction to Microsoft Teams video
- Create <u>teams and channels</u>. Each department should designate one person to make a team and help organize your group. A good rule of thumb is to be specific with the team name (ex. IT Department) and keep the number of teams limited. You can utilize Channels within the team to keep conversations organized. Organize by projects, subsets of the department, etc.
- Start a private or group <u>chat</u> to communicate via text, audio, or video
- Schedule meetings and calls.
- View recent activities in your <u>activity feed</u>
- View, edit, and share <u>files</u>.
- <u>Integrate apps</u> to add content or features using <u>tabs</u>.
